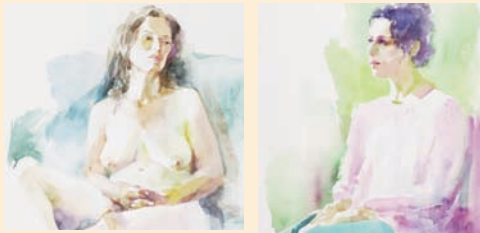

Maureen will be giving a Figure Demonstration with a live nude model at the opening at 2pm.

Member's admission to the demo is Free, Non-Members admission is \$5.00, and membership will be checked for this event.

** Maureen Fain will be showcasing her works at RIWS, July 7 - August 1*

Watercolor Techniques relating to the body will be introduced. The model will be posed in various ways to show the use of different techniques and tonal values of the poses. Color choices and mixing flesh tones will be discussed, including transparent colors for layering and opaque ones for more impressionistic paintings. Students will paint various poses of the model and be instructed on how to paint hands and feet.

About the instructor:

Maureen has had 20 solo exhibitions, notably in Paris, the

USA, Norway, South Africa, as well as in Israel. She had a special exhibition of watercolor nudes at the Israel Museum in 1994. She has participated in over 40 group exhibitions, notably an international group exhibition in London in March 2011, and was one of five Israeli women artists who were invited to exhibit in Berlin in 1999, as guests of the German Government, the City of Berlin and the National Association for Women in the Arts. Maureen has taught watercolor at the Israel Museum since 1990

2nd Annual Tiverton Visiting Artist Gallery Exhibition - Call for Entries

July 19 - August 1. Opening: Friday, July 20

12 - 4 pm at the Visiting Artist Gallery

RIWS is returning to the Visiting Artist Gallery in Tiverton this summer.

The show will run from July 19th - August 1st just in time for the South Coast Artist Tours on July 20th and 21st.

The opening reception will be July 20th from 12 - 4pm.

ELIGIBILITY: You must be an **Artist or Signature Artist Member** to submit a painting into this invitational show.

MEDIA: Water media only

Entry: Paintings can be dropped off to the **RIWS** gallery July 1st - July 14th. We will deliver your paintings to Tiverton. If it is more convenient for you to drop off your work to the Tiverton gallery, please call **RIWS** to make arrangements.

Entry Fee is \$14.00. This includes 1 painting to be hung, 2 matted bin paintings, and small gift table items such as: cards, tiles and small paintings frame size 5x7. All artists entering work into this invitational show must sign up to volunteer or sit a 3 hour shift either at the Visiting Artist Gallery in Tiverton or at **RIWS** in Pawtucket. You can sign up for a shift when you drop off your work. If you do not want to or are unable to volunteer, the entry fee is \$35.00.

Last year, over 3,000 art enthusiasts and buyers flooded the area for the 2 day self guided tour, and our sales reached \$2,500. This is a great opportunity to get your work out there for many people to see and enjoy!
